

Q: Is there space for the bridal party to get ready?

A: Yes, we have a studio apartment that is detached from our main residence. We also have 3 bedrooms in our main residence which includes use of our common areas such as the back deck and living spaces. You can allocate these spaces for your bridal party however you choose.

Q: Can we bring our own Alcohol?

A: Yes, you will need to provide a copy of an RSA licence and/or liquor licence.

Q: How many cars can park?

A: 110 cars can fit on the property.

Q: Will there be someone on site during the day to assist if something goes wrong?

A: Yes, there will be someone from Bidja Estate onsite over the time of your wedding and lead-up.

Q: Can we throw confetti?

A: We do not allow confetti, or rice. We would request natural biodegradable items only such as flower petals or bubbles

Q: When can we start setting up?

A: You will have access to the property at 12 noon the day prior to your wedding day.

Q: When do we need to bump out?

Accommodation checkout is 10.30am on the day after the wedding.

Property pack down and clean up is required by 12 noon on the day after your event. Please note we require your third party vendors to adhere to these same time lines, and if not a charge of \$500 per day will be taken out of your refundable bond.

Q: Can we move things around?

A: If you move things around, you will need to place them back in their place upon departure, being mindful of not damaging or treating our equipment roughly.

Q: Can we deliver stuff off in the days leading up to the wedding?

A: Only by prior arrangement with us at Bidja Estate.

Q: What time is curfew?

A: We require all music to be turned off at midnight and lights out and guests that are not staying onsite to be off property by 3am.

Q: Can we have candles (some venues don't allow open flame)?

A: During the summer months where there are fire bans, we allow battery operated candles only. During cooler months you can use the fire-pit, however you will need to supply your own wood.

Q: Will we need to bring our own sound system?

A: Yes you will need to provide your own. If you need assistance please request to see our vendors list.

Q: How much accommodation is nearby? Do you have any partnerships with any accommodation providers where we get a discount?

A: There are some local Airbnbs in the area. We would suggest Crowne Plaza Terrigal Pacific, Koondah Waters or Magenta Shores where group bookings can be made and buses can be hired to transport your guests to and from these venues. Please refer to our vendors list for these details

Q: What do you suggest in the event of bad weather?

A: Depending on the number of guests attending, and the setup style of your wedding the red barn can be used as your wet weather option.

Please speak to us on the day of your site inspection to discuss layout and seating numbers.

Q. Do you have in-house catering or preferred caterers, or can I bring my own?

A: We do have some preferred vendors we can recommend. However, you are entitled to engage your own caterers. You need to supply us with a copy of their public liability insurance policy and other food related licences.

Q: What are the facilities for the caterer?

A: The majority of caterers provide their own equipment and are usually self sufficient. We do not provide facilities for caterers, however we do provide undercover space in our working shed which has direct access to power and water.

Q: Do you find that caterers need to bring in anything extra (e.g. heating oven, extra refrigeration etc.)

A: Yes, you can ask your caterer these questions, they are usually self-sufficient.

Please note that you do have also have a cool room provided with your property hire.



Q: Is there a fire pit? Do we need to BYO wood?

A: Yes, there is a fire pit. Yes, you will need to BYO wood (check with us at Bidja Estate)

Q: Is the venue handicap accessible (if you have any guests with mobility needs)

A: Yes, the venue is handicap accessible. Please advise us if you require accessible toilet access as we will ensure that this is ordered for your day.

Q: What happens with rubbish? Do you remove or do we? Do you have recycling?

A: We provide 6 recyclable bins for your use. We require you to clean up your own rubbish and place it into the various bins. Your bins will be removed by the vendor the day after bump-out.

Please note if the property is not left in the same state it was found, a cleaning charge will be deducted from your bond.
